Pregnancy: 08/2008—05/2009

Weeks 3-5: Mum had a cold and a fever;

Medicines taken:

Bak Foong Pills (Chinese medicine);

Chinese medicine for cold and flu (couldn't remember the exact name);

Antibiotics: Cefalexin Capsules

28/05/2009-29/05/2009

Pitocin—Labor induction (excessive use)

Epidural --- Emergency C section;

Parent's note:

i) HL had extra digits on the right hand and both feet;

ii) HL had diarrhea symptoms when mum is breastfeeding him:

About 9-14 times poo every day until 11/2009;

Frequent use of nappy cream (**Sudocrem/metanium**) until 09/2009;

28/07/2009

5-in-1 (DTaP/IPV/Hib) vaccine

Pneumococcal (PCV)

20/08/2009

BCG vaccination

01/09/2009

5-in-1 (DTaP/IPV/Hib) vaccine

Meningitis C (Men C)

Parent's note: Since 09/2009, HL was finding it difficult to fall asleep, woke up frequently in the evening (2-8 times) until 12/2011

29/09/2009

5-in-1 (DTaP/IPV/Hib) vaccine

Pneumococcal (PCV), 2nd dose;

Parent's note:

We have noticed HL's Nystagmus around October-November 2009;

He started to have eczema and still has it until now, regular use of **E45/**

Cetraben, occasional use of **steroid Hydrocortisone**;

03/2010

Mum used antibiotic **Amoxicillin** due to her toothache. HL was still being breastfed.

09/06/2010

Hib/Men C booster vaccination;

06/2010

Surgery—Remove extra digit on the right hand;
Anesthetic;
Amoxicillin (Taken for about 10 days);

Parent's note: During the course of Amoxicillin, HL became very excited and couldn't sleep after midnight; After the surgery, HL hardly made any speech sounds; He is also obsessed with stacking cups;

07/07/2010

Measles, mumps and rubella (MMR) vaccine
Pneumococcal (PCV) vaccine, third dose;

10/2010

Fever and Chest infection: Calpol and Amoxicillin;

12/2010

Fever and Chest infection: Calpol, ibuprofen and Amoxicillin;

02/2011

Fever and Chest infection: Calpol, ibuprofen and Amoxicillin;

Parent's note: In 03/2011, HL's child minder reported to us that HL had problems for eye contact with other kids, but good eye contacts with adults;

08/2012

Surgery—Remove extra digit on the right hand;
Anesthetic;
Amoxicillin;

Parent's note: After the surgery, HL becomes hyperactive and had a big regression in potty training. He also had several tantrums afterwards. Grandma felt it was very difficult to handle him.

22/10/2012

Measles, mumps and rubella (MMR) vaccine, second dose
4-in-1 (DTaP/IPV) vaccine, pre-school booster

Parent's note: HL's stimming activities have been substantially increased after Jan. 2013. He did lots of jumping, self-spinning, head shaking and hands flapping etc.

08/2013-09/2013

Rabies vaccination (4 shots)

Parent's note: HL became easily irritated. He had less eye contact with other children and obsessed with only 1-2 things;
